

## CORNWALL TOWN BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS -- 2004

1. Swim at your own risk.
2. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed.
3. Admittance to the beach is by permit only.
4. Children under 12 must be accompanied by persons 16 years of age or older.
5. Adults please accompany small children when using toilet facilities.
6. Dogs are not allowed.
7. Vehicles must not be parked in the driveway. Emergency vehicles need access.
8. Please do not trespass beyond designated beach area.
9. For your safety do not swim under docks or rafts.
10. Running on the docks or rafts is not allowed.
11. Please do not play ball, toss Frisbees, or rough-house on the beach. There is not enough room for such activities.
12. Floating objects are not allowed outside of the beginners' area.
13. Be courteous, do not play radios or recorders without personal earphones.
14. Launching of boats, rafts or boards is not permitted from the beach area.
15. Fishing is not allowed from the beach area.
16. Please do not swim beyond the buoys.
17. To keep the coli count down, please have children wear bathing suits or diapers except for brief rinsing or changing.
18. Please do not smoke.

Be aware that permits may be revoked without recourse by the Beach Director for failure to obey beach regulations.

Patrons who verbally or physically abuse lifeguards will be asked to leave. Any questions or complaints must be directed to the beach director.

Guests are limited to 5 per card holder per visit and are to be accompanied by a permit holder.

Guest fees are: Adults: \$1.00; Children under 16: \$.50.

Lost permit cards can be replaced by the Beach Director or Selectmen's Office.

Beach hours are 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from June 18, 2004 through Labor Day Weekend. Use of the beach after it is closed is prohibited.

Sign up for swimming lessons and town swim team is from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. the week of June 21-25 at the beach.
