

# CORNWALL TRANSFER STATION

**HOURS:** Tues., Thurs. & Sat.: 9:00 - 4:30 p.m.  
Sunday: 8:00 - 11:00 a.m.

- We can only accept garbage and trash generated IN THE TOWN OF CORNWALL with Transfer Sticker.

Obtain Transfer Sticker from Transfer Station attendants.

**ELECTRONICS** are a hazardous waste. They are not allowed per order of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection at the transfer station. Residents will be notified by publication of a special hazardous waste collection day for electronics and other hazardous wastes such as oil paints, stains, pesticides, poisons, household cleaners, fluorescent light bulbs, propane tanks.

**RECYCLING:** Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection has mandated recycling.

PLACE IN SEPARATE CONTAINERS:

loose & rinsed:

milk cartons  
juice boxes (aseptic)  
metal cans  
clean aluminum foil  
cardboard  
glass jars (w/no lids)  
cartons  
wax milk containers  
juice box containers (aseptic)  
plastic #1 & 2 no bigger than  
one gallon size (no lids)  
cannot accept motor oil, pesticide  
or antifreeze containers  
no redeemable containers

bundled in brown bags:

newspapers  
magazines  
catalogs  
corrugated cardboard  
3'x3' & smaller

loose:

office paper  
junk paper  
cereal boxes  
shoebox  
egg

**Please rinse** bleach, ammonia, milk, etc. containers for the attendant's safety. :)

**Cardboard bigger than 3' x 3'** is to be flattened and kept separate to be baled.

-- on Sundays only Household waste - no bulk, no metal --

- 1. METAL** other than cans goes into the metal bin if space is available. Fees apply. **Pay as you dump.**
- 2. Bulky waste** accepted only when space available - **call first!** 672-6230 Fees apply. **Pay as you dump.**
- All **WOOD, plywood, pressboard** goes into bulky waste. Fees apply. **Pay as you dump.**

- Bulky waste, woods, metal: Please reduce, cut, compact prior to dumping. Maximum length 4 feet.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** We accept for recycling and/or redistribution:

**NiCad batteries**

**polystyrene peanuts** (the packing kind)

**clean, used clothing** in good condition can be placed in the large bin outside the gate.

**waste oil and antifreeze**

**eye glasses**

**food labels: Campbells, Franco American**

**books**

**FEES FOR BULKY WASTE - SEE ATTENDANT BEFORE DUMPING:**

No Bulky Waste on Sundays - Payment expected at time of dumping

Mattress or box spring	\$10.00 and up
Large Metal Appliances	\$10.00 and up
Standard Pick-Up Truck-load	\$50.00 pro-rated for partial loads
Auto batteries	\$5.00 and up
Automobile tires	\$3.00 each
Light truck tires up to size 825/20	\$5.00 each
Tires on rims add	\$1.00 each
Tractor or large truck tires	variable rate - ask in advance

**BULKY WASTE: Pay as you dump. THE TRANSFER STATION WILL ACCEPT (not on Sundays), "BULKY WASTE" UP TO 2.5 YARDS (a standard pickup load) PER RESIDENCE OR BUSINESS PER MONTH AT \$50. ONLY NON-HAZARDOUS MATERIALS CAN BE DUMPED. THIS INCLUDES WOOD, FURNITURE, ETC. WASTE MUST BE IN SIZE AND SHAPE ACCEPTABLE TO THE TRANSFER STATION OPERATOR.**

**DEMOLITION MATERIALS: Not accepted on Sundays:**

\$50.00 per standard pick-up load. Limit one \$50 load per month per residence.

**Lumber must not be longer than 4' in length.**

For major amounts the rental of a dumpster is necessary.

Shingles: Make arrangements at Transfer Station prior to disposal.

**SCRAP METAL:** See attendant for fees.

**YARD WASTE:** Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection does not permit the disposal of yard wastes (i.e. leaves, grass clippings) at transfer stations.

Please compost your yard waste, wreaths, plants, animal waste with your kitchen waste of fruit & vegetable peelings. Composting can reduce solid waste by 40%!

**BRUSH, LOGS & STUMPS**

**BRUSH BURNING:** Brush can be burned only with a permit and during low risk weather. Obtain permit beforehand at the Selectman's Office, 8:30 - 3:30 Mon-Thurs, 672-4959.

**BRUSH TO BRUSH DUMP:** \$25.00 a pick-up load; \$50.00 dump-truck load; 5 yard maximum. Prior arrangement is needed to deliver brush to the brush dump at the gravel bank. **Call Donnie** at the Highway Garage at 672-6230 Monday-Friday between 7:00 and 7:30 a.m. Checks for fees charged may be mailed to Selectmen's Office, Town of Cornwall, P.O. Box 205, Cornwall, CT 06753.

**LOGS AND STUMPS :** Too large to burn and not accepted at the brush dump. Call Supreme Industries in Harwinton 485-0343 or Steve Leining in Sheffield, Mass. (413) 528-8066 for removal.

**FOR YOUR INFORMATION:**

Cornwall's trash is hauled to West Hartford to be burned in a Waste to Energy Facility. Power produced from this process is sold at a reduced rate to the state. For every three tons of waste burned, there is one ton of radioactive waste to be buried in a special landfill.

Fees for recycling are three to four times cheaper than the cost of hauling to the incinerator. RECYCLE! Save Cornwall's money!
